- (8) Manufacturer supplied VOC Data Sheets and/or Material Safety Data Sheets for all coatings applied at this facility within the most recent two years shall be maintained at the above location and be made available to the Department at any time.
- (9) Records required under this operating permit shall be kept for a period of five (5) years and shall be made available to the Department upon its request.
- (10) This Operating Permit is valid for a limited period of time and may be renewed before its expiration. Requests for an Operating Permit Renewal must be in writing and must be accompanied by a permit fee in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) payable to the "Clean Air Fund" (three hundred dollars (\$300.00) application processing fee and three hundred dollars (\$300.00) annual administration fee). The request should be made on the attached Interim Application for Renewal of a Permit to Operate form and must be received by the Department along with a completed Compliance History form (attached) no later than March 1, 2000.

An annual Operating Permit administration fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) is also due upon receipt of notice from the Department.

- (11) The company shall record the quantity and identity of all VOC solvents used for cleanup purposes on the sources on a daily basis. These records shall be maintained and shall be made part of the company's annual "AIMS" report to the Department.
