4. This permit is for the incorporation of the Department's VOC Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) requirements (25 Pa. Code, §§129.91 through 129.95) for the Hollidaysburg Car Shop.

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7. Annual reports containing, but not limited to, the following data shall be submitted to the Harrisburg District Supervisor:

a. For each surface coating employed at the facility:

- (1) coating identification
- (2) coating use (e.g., extreme performance coating)
- (3) lbs of VOC per gallon coating (minus water)
- (4) coating density
- (5) solvent density
- (6) % solvents (volume) - (minus EPA exempted solvents)
- (7) % solids (volume)
- (8) % water (volume)
- (9) gallons per month of coating used (plus water)
- (10) gallons per month of coating used (minus water)
- (11) lbs of VOC emissions per reporting period from the surface coating operations

Conditions, Continued

b. For each cleanup solvent and degreaser used at the facility:

- (1) cleanup solvent/degreaser identification
- (2) use (e.g., cleanup solvent)
- (3) lbs of VOC per gallon of cleanup solvent/degreaser
- (4) gallons per month of cleanup solvent/degreaser used
- (5) lbs of VOC emissions per reporting period from the cleanup solvent/
degreaser operations

Each report (January 1 through December 31) is due no later than March 1 of the following year for each operating year authorized by the operating permit or its renewal. The report must contain monthly usage of coatings and its VOC emissions.

- 8. Any new coating or any compositional changes in an existing surface coating shall be reported to the Harrisburg District Supervisor prior to its use. Information to be reported shall include Items (1) through and including (8) of the above Condition 7.a.
- 9. Should credits be desired for those cleanup solvents and degreasers sent off-site for either recycling or incineration at a legally permitted facility, the following information will be required:
 - a. the quantities being disposed of
 - b. the VOC content of the cleanup solvents and degreasers being disposed of
 - c. documentation to verify the above
- 10. Manufacturer supplied VOC Data Sheets and/or Material Safety Data Sheets for all surface coatings applied and cleanup solvents/degreasers utilized at this facility within the most recent two year period shall be maintained at the above location and be made available to the Department at any time.

~~11. All degreaser units at the facility shall comply with the said degreaser requirements as per 25 Pa. Code, Section 129.62(a).~~

~~12. The company shall maintain records in accordance with the recordkeeping requirements of 25 Pa. Code, Sections 129.61 and 129.62.~~

- 13. The company shall maintain records in accordance with the recordkeeping requirements of 25 Pa. Code, Section 129.95.
