

Special Conditions:

3. This RACT Permit approves the RACT proposal for the continued operation of sources at the Consol Inc. Robena facility located in Monongahela Township, Greene County.
4. This facility is subject to the record keeping requirements of 25 PA Code §129.95.
5. VOC emissions from this facility shall not be in excess of 62 tons for a consecutive 12 month period.
6. Compliance with the emission limitations specified in this permit shall be determined through the annual submittal of a report detailing the emissions from the facility and the method of determining the emissions.
