

In accordance with provisions of the Air Pollution Control Act, the Act of January 8, 1960, P. L. 2119, as amended, and with Chapter 127 of the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Resources, the Department on **JUN 27 1995** approved plans for achieving compliance by the above indicated air contamination source(s) with the requirements of 25 Pa Code Section 129.91 through 129.95.

The operating permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. The facility is to be operated in accordance with the plan submitted with the application as approved herein.

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Section (SAT21)

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2. NOx emissions from each boiler shall not exceed 0.39 lbs/MMBTU, 11.4 lbs/hr and 49.82 tons/yr. When only one boiler is operating, the NOx emission shall not exceed 22.8 lbs/hr.
3. The facility shall submit quarterly NOx emission reports to the Department. The quarterly NOx emissions shall not exceed 24.9 tons for both boilers and 21.8 tons for the Battery Underfire Operation System.
4. NOx emissions from the Battery Underfire Operation System shall not exceed 19.9 lbs/hr and 87.16 tons/yr.
~~5. VOC emissions from the facility shall not exceed 10.1 tons/yr.~~
6. Implementation of the RACT must be completed no later than May 31, 1995.
7. Erie Coke shall perform annual tune-ups for Boilers # 1 and #2. Records of the tune-ups will be retained on-site for a minimum of two years.
8. Erie Coke shall operate and maintain their boilers in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications and the sources shall also be operated and maintained in accordance with good air pollution control practices.
9. Erie Coke shall maintain their Battery Underfire Operation according to good heating practices and operate and maintain the source in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. The source shall also be operated and maintained in accordance with good air pollution control practices.
10. Boiler #1, Boiler #3, and Battery Underfire system shall be stack tested for NOx emissions at least once a year (or annually) starting no later than May 31, 1995. Sampling shall be performed in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapter 120 for testing NOx emissions from stationary sources. If, after three (3) consecutive annual tests, emission data consistently show compliance with RACT emission limits, the testing frequency may be altered as determined by the Department.
11. At least thirty (30) days prior to stack testing, Erie Coke shall submit a copy of the test plan to the Regional Office. The plan shall include sampling procedures, specific test methods, procedures and equipment, and additional applicable information regarding planned test protocol.
12. At least two weeks prior to the tests, the Department shall receive a copy of the test plan.
13. Within 60 days after completion of the tests, two copies of the complete test report, including all operational parameters, shall be submitted to the Department for review.

14. This site approval applies to the facility SVO - LVOG, [Redacted] only. [Redacted] shall be governed by the existing Plan Approvals, Operating Permit, and applicable Rules and Regulations of the Department. Such approval, permits, and requirements are incorporated herein by reference and made part of this permit.
15. Any information required to be submitted as part of the conditions in this Operating Permit shall be submitted to Mr. Devendra Verma, Engineering Services Chief, Air Quality Control, Northwest Regional Office 1812 Water Street, Meadville, PA [Redacted] 16339.
