**Permit Conditions**

3. This RACT Operating Permit is for operational limitations at the Johnstown Corporation foundry located in Johnstown, Cambria County.

4. Johnstown Corporation shall limit the coal consumption the CNB tri-fuel boiler to a coal consumption of 1100 tpy and keep records which clearly demonstrate compliance with this condition.

5. Metal production from the three EAF's at this facility shall be limited to a combined total of 62,640 tpy and records shall be kept which clearly demonstrate compliance with this condition.

6. Natural gas usage at this facility shall be limited to 600,000 MCF/yr and records shall be kept which clearly demonstrate compliance with this condition.

8. The record keeping required in this permit shall be performed on a monthly basis. This data should be summarized and submitted to the Department in the form of a yearly report. All data shall be maintained at this facility for a period of not less than two years and be made available to the Department upon request.
