FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI)

To all interested government agencies, public groups, and individuals:

In accordance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) procedures for implementing the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) (40 CFR Part 6), EPA has completed an environmental review of the following proposed action:

Award of EPA Climate Showcase Community Grant Funds to the City of Keene, NH

As an applicant for the Climate Showcase Community Grant Program administered by the EPA, the City of Keene and its project partners will install a biofuel generator which will ultimately be the primary energy source for the Keene Material Recovery Facility.

The environmental review process, which is documented by the enclosed Environmental Assessment, indicates that no significant environmental impacts are anticipated from the proposed action. Accordingly, EPA is issuing this preliminary Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) to document this determination for public review for a period of 30 days. After evaluating any comments received, the EPA will make a final decision. The preliminary FONSI will become final after the 30-day comment period expires if EPA receives no substantive comments, and no new significant information is provided to alter this preliminary finding.
