
This permit is subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS (continued):

6. RACT Determination

The company shall follow the Work Practice Implementation Plan and Cleaning Procedures submitted with the RACT application, which have been determined to meet the requirements of RACT for the clean-up operations.

7. The company shall keep the following:

- i) record of each finished material
- ii) records of VOC and solid content, as applied, of each finishing material
- iii) records demonstrating that the operator training program is in place
- iv) records associated with the cleaning solvent accounting system

8. Records shall be maintained for a period of five years and shall be made available to the Department upon its request.
