OPERATING PERMIT

In accordance with provisions of the Air Pollution Control Act, the act of January 8, 1960, P.L. 2119, as amended, and after due consideration of an application received under Chapter 127 of the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department hereby issues this permit for the operation of the air contamination source(s) described below:

1. That the source(s) and any associated air cleaning devices are to be:
 - a. operated in such a manner as not to cause air pollution;
 - b. in compliance with the specifications and conditions of the plan approval issued under the same number;
 - c. operated and maintained in a manner consistent with good operating and maintenance practices.

2. This permit is valid only for the specific equipment, location and owner named above.

CONDITIONS (CONTINUED):

3. This RACT Operating Permit includes Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) determinations as required by Title I provisions of the CAAA, and 25 PA Code Sections 129.91 through 129.95 for 2 screen presses, Easi-wase screen washing system, and 3 Heidelberg presses.
4. Each of the following de minimis source categories shall be operated with VOC emission rates of no greater than 3 pounds per hour, 15 pounds per day and 2.7 tons per year whichever is more strict: Combustion units, Mixing Activities and Solvent Degreasers. If at any time these limits are exceeded, a detailed RACT analysis will be required.
5. The aforementioned source(s) may be operated and used so long as any associated air pollution control devices are operated and maintained in accordance with the specifications set forth in the respective plan approval(s), and the application(s) submitted for said plan approval(s), (as approved by the Department), and in accordance with any conditions set forth herein.
6. The expiration date shown on this RACT Operating Permit is for State purposes. For Federal Enforcement purposes the Operating Permit shall remain in effect as part of the State Implementation Plan (SIP) until replaced pursuant to 40 CFR 51 and approved by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The Operating Permit shall become enforceable by the US EPA upon its approval of the above as a revision to the SIP.
7. The operation of the entire printing facility shall not at any time result in the emission of any air contaminant in excess of the limitations specified in, or established pursuant to, any applicable rule or regulation contained in Article III of the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection.
8. The company shall within one hour of occurrence notify the Department of any malfunction of the printing presses which results in, or may possibly be resulting in, the emission of air contaminants in excess of the limitations specified herein or specified in, or established pursuant to, any applicable rule or regulation contained in Article III of the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection.
9. If the above mentioned presses are taken out of operation for a period of one year or more during the term of this operating permit, the permittee shall not thereafter resume operation of the respective source unless a reactivation plan has first been submitted to, and approved by, the Department.
10. The company shall maintain records in accordance with the record keeping requirements of 25 PA Code Section 129.95.
11. The total Volatile Organic Compound emissions from this facility shall not exceed 68 tons per year (as calculated by the Department).

CONDITIONS (CONTINUED):

12. The lids of containers and drums which hold VOC-containing inks, solvents and thinners shall always be closed, except when materials are being added to or taken from the containers or drums, or are being prepared for use.
13. Wet rags shall be stored in closed containers.
14. Any spills of inks, solvents and thinners shall be cleaned as soon as possible.
15. ~~The conditions of this operating permit shall be added to those contained in the Title V operating permit.~~
16. ~~If at any time the permittee causes, permits or allows any modification (as that term is defined in Chapter 121 of Title 25, the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection) of the aforementioned air contamination source(s), the operation and use of which is authorized by this permit, or causes, permits or allows any modifications, malfunction or removal of any air pollution control device required as a condition of this permit, then and in that event, this permit shall be suspended, and the permittee shall not thereafter continue to operate or use said air contamination source(s).~~
