- 3. This RACT Plan Approval is for the installation of a Dry Mill (two 30SC attritors), Water Mill & Spray Dryer, and Vibratory Manufacturing System. This operation will be controlled by a new cyclone and baghouse. Newcomer Products, Incorporated (NPI) is located in Latrobe, Pa. Westmoreland County.
- 4. All VOC emissions from NPI in Latrobe shall be kept on record at this facility.
- A monthly log shall be kept of all VOC-containing materials purchased, consumed, and inventory on hand at the facility. These records shall be maintained in a file for a period of not less than two years and made available to the Department upon request.
- No heptane shall be used in the milling, powder making, and the carbide pellet making processes unless approved by the Department.
