



The kitchen cabinet finish line consists of the following:

Stain Booth	Koch
Sealer Booth	Koch
Top Coat Booth	Koch
Oven	Koch/Eclipse
Sanding & Cleaning Operation	Koch
Paint Spray Booth	Devilbiss

1. The paint booths are controlled by fiberglass filters (Chemco Mfg. Company).

Conditions, Continued

2. This Plan Approval authorizes temporary operation of the source(s) covered by this Plan Approval provided the following conditions are met:

- a. The Department must receive written notice from Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc. of the completion of construction and Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc.'s intent to commence operation at least five (5) working days prior to the completion of construction. The notice must state when construction will be completed and when Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc. expects to commence operation.
- b. Operation is authorized only to facilitate the start-up and shake-down of sources and air cleaning devices, to permit operations pending the issuance of an Operating Permit or to permit the evaluation of the source(s) for compliance with all applicable regulations and requirements.
- c. This condition authorizes temporary operation of the source(s) for a period of 180 days from the date of commencement of operation, provided the Department receives notice from Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc. pursuant to subpart a., above.
- ~~d. Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc. may request an extension if compliance with all applicable regulations and Plan Approval requirements has not been established. The extension request shall be submitted in writing at least 15 days prior to the end of this period of temporary operation and shall provide a description of the compliance status of the source, a detailed schedule for establishing compliance, and the reasons compliance has not been established.~~
- ~~e. The notice submitted by Plain 'n Fancy Kitchens, Inc. pursuant to subpart a., above, prior to the expiration of this Plan Approval, shall modify the plan approval expiration date. The new plan approval expiration date shall be 180 days from the date of the written notice.~~

3. As of May 23, 1993, the VOC content for Wood Cabinet and Furniture Finishing coatings, as applied, shall be equal to or less than the listed defined coatings (minus water) after adjusting to a standard solvent density of 7.36 lbs/gal and to a solids basis as per 25 Pa. Code §129.52(b)(1):

a. clear topcoat	5.9
b. wash coat	6.5
c. final repair coat	6.0
d. semitransparent wiping and glazing stains	6.4
e. semitransparent spray stains and toners	6.8
f. opaque ground coats and enamels	5.5
g. all other coatings	7.0
h. clear sealers	6.2

4. Annual reports containing, but not limited to, the following data for each coating shall be submitted to the Harrisburg District Supervisor:

- a. coating identification
- b. coating use (e.g., clear topcoat)
- c. lbs. of VOC per gallon coating (minus water)
- d. coating density
- e. solvent density
- f. % solvents (volume) - (minus EPA exempted solvents)
- g. % solids (volume)
- h. % water (volume)
- i. gallons per year of coating (plus water)
- j. gallons per year of coating used (minus water)
- k. lbs. per year of VOC emissions
- l. total days and hours of operation for each source for the year

Each report (January 1 through December 31) is due no later than March 1 of the following year for each operating year authorized by the operating permit or its renewal. The report must contain monthly usage of coatings and its VOC emissions.

5. Any new coating or any compositional change in an existing coating shall be reported to the Harrisburg District Supervisor prior to its use. Information to be reported shall include Items a. through h. of the above Condition 4 along with Material Safety Data Sheets.
6. The company shall not operate the kitchen cabinet finish line more than 2,600 hours per year. The emission of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) must be kept below 50 tons per year. This limit shall be based on the current 12-month running total.
7. Manufacturer supplied VOC Data Sheets and/or Material Safety Data Sheets for all coatings applied at this facility within the most recent two years shall be maintained at the above location and be made available to the Department at any time.
