This permit is subject to the following conditions:


- (1) That the source and any associated air cleaning devices are to be:
 - (a) operated in such a manner as not to cause air pollution;
 - (b) in compliance with the specifications and conditions of the plan approval issued under the same number;
 - (c) operated and maintained in a manner consistent with good operating and maintenance practices.
- (2) This permit is valid only for the specific equipment, location and owner named above.

Failure to comply with the conditions placed on this permit is in violation of Section 127.444. Violation of this or any other provision of Article III of the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection will result in suspension or revocation of this permit and/or prosecution under Section 9 of the Air Pollution Control Act.

- (3) This Operating Permit incorporates Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) determination for VOC as required by Title I provisions of the CAAA, and 25 Pa. Code Sections 129.91 through 129.95 for the following sources:
 - (a) Household towel (HHT) Line #1 with a capacity of 279 cases/hr.
 - (b) Household towel (HHT) Line #2 with a capacity of 144 cases/hr.
 - (c) Household towel (HHT) Line #3 with a capacity of 173 cases/hr.
 - (d) Napkin line with a capacity of 102 cases/hr.
 - (e) Corrugated printers 1600 boxes/hour/unit.
- (4) The company shall use ink with the volatile fraction of the ink, as applied to the substrate, contains 25% or less by volume of VOC and 75% or more by volume of water.
- (5) The company shall keep on hand chemical composition data for all of the materials, to include all materials used in the flexographic printing process. The facility shall indicate all volatile organic compounds (VOC) materials usage on the aforementioned sources. These records shall be maintained and made available to the Department upon request.
- (6) Recordkeeping and reporting requirements are as follows:
 - (a) The company shall maintain a file containing all records and other data that are required to be collected pursuant to the various provisions of this operating permit, 25 PA Code Section 129.95, such that records provide sufficient data and calculations to clearly demonstrate that the requirements of 25 Pa. Code Sections 129.91-4 are met. The file shall include, but not be limited to: a record of all VOC containing compounds used at the facility as well as calculations on the entire facilities VOC emissions (updated quarterly [3 months]); all air pollution control system performance evaluations and records of calibration checks, adjustments and maintenance performed on all equipment which is subject to this Operating Permit. All measurements, records and other data required to be maintained by the company shall be retained for at least two years following the date on which such measurements, records or data are recorded. These records shall be made available to the Department upon request.
