OPERATING PERMIT

In accordance with provisions of the Air Pollution Control Act, the Act of January 8, 1960, P.L. 2119, as amended, and after due consideration of an application received under Chapter 127 of the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department hereby issues this permit for the operation of the air contamination source described below.

This permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the source and any associated air cleaning devices are to be:
  - a. operated in such a manner as not to cause air pollution;
  - b. in compliance with the specifications and conditions of the Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) plan;
  - c. operated and maintained in a manner consistent with good operating and maintenance practices.
2. This permit is valid only for the specific equipment, location and owner named above.
3. This operating permit is valid for a limited time only and may be renewed before its expiration. Requests for an operating permit renewal must be in writing and must be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$600 payable to the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania - Clean Air Fund." The request should be made on the attached Interim Application for Renewal of a Permit to Operate form and must be received by the Department along with a completed Compliance History form (attached) no later than \_\_\_\_\_.

Failure to comply with the conditions placed on this permit is a violation of Section 127.444. Violation of this or any other provision of Article III of the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection will result in suspension or revocation of this permit and/or prosecution under Section 9 of the Air Pollution Control Act.

Conditions, Continued

4. This permit constitutes a RACT determination for oxides of nitrogen (NO<sub>x</sub>) emissions as per 25 Pa. Code, Sections 129.91 and 129.92 for the Stone Container Corporation York paperboard mill.
5. All air pollution sources and air pollution control devices shall be operated and maintained in accordance with good pollution control practices that minimize the emissions of NO<sub>x</sub>.
6. Total annual NO<sub>x</sub> emissions from Boiler Nos. 5 and 6 shall not exceed 425 tons for any consecutive 12-month period.
7. The Biothane Corporation flare shall be operated in accordance with the applicable requirements of 25 Pa. Code, Section 129.93(c).
8. An annual report as per Section 129.95 containing, but not limited to, the following data for combustion sources shall be submitted to the York District Supervisor:

Boiler Nos. 5 and 6

- a. Identification of each unit
- b. hours of operation per month for each unit
- c. fuel combusted per month for each unit
- d. NO<sub>x</sub> emissions per month for each unit

Biothane Corporation flare

- a. annual hours of operation
- b. annual fuel combusted
- c. annual NO<sub>x</sub> emissions

The reports required under Condition 8 above for each January 1 through December 31 period are due no later than March 1 of the following year for each year authorized by the operating permit or its renewal.
