The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located adjacent to and west of Park Road 56 in Polk County, Texas. The facility is on Alabama-Coushatta Tribal lands. Under the Standard Industrial Classification Code 4952, the applicant operates a POTW with a design flow of 0.12 MGD for a population of 991 residents. The effluent from the treatment plant is discharged to Tombigbee Creek below Tombigbee Lake thence to Bear Creek, thence to Big Sandy Creek, thence to Village Creek in Segment 0608 of the Neches River Basin, at Latitude 30° 42' 30" North, Longitude 94° 40' 45" West. The designated uses of Segment 0608 are high aquatic life, contact recreation and public water supply.

This is the reissuance of a permit issued July 17, 2012, with an effective date of August 1, 2012, and an expiration date of July 31, 2017.

Changes to the draft permit from the previous permit are:

1. Total Residual Chlorine limit changed to protect WQS per 40 CFR 122.4(d) and 122.44(d).
