The facility is a new discharger located in Cameron County, Texas (Latitude 25 ° 59' 23.93" N; Longitude 97 ° 21' 23.07" to Latitude 26° 3' 18.54" N; Longitude 97° 9' 16.46" W). EPA proposes that this permit be issued. A Statement of Basis is available, and describes the rationale for permit conditions. Under the SIC code 4922, 4923, 4924, and 4925, Valley Crossing Pipeline LLC. plans to transmit and distribute natural gas.
