

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. OK0044881

The proposed permit allows only the hydrostatic test discharge water from new oil storage tanks associated with the Keystone Pipeline near Cushing, Oklahoma. The discharge point showing outfall number, discharge coordinates: latitude and longitude, county, average flow rate in millions gallons per day (MGD), receiving water, and the waterbody identification numbers are shown in the table below:

Under the SIC Code 4612, the applicant is engaged in Crude Petroleum Pipelines. The new oil storage tanks will undergo hydrostatic testing in four phases.
