The Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District would like to participate in Ozone Advance with respect to Jefferson County, Kentucky. We wish to join this partnership with EPA to preserve or improve the air quality in Louisville Metro and we meet the program eligibility criteria, i.e.:

- (1) Jefferson County is not currently a nonattainment area for either the 1997 8-hour or the 2008 ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).
- (2) The area consists of Jefferson, Oldham and Bullitt counties in Kentucky and Clark and Floyd counties in Indiana.
- (3) The following air monitors reflect the air quality in Louisville Metro:

- (4) Existing emissions inventory reporting requirements have been met.

We understand that our efforts under Ozone Advance may benefit Louisville Metro by potentially:

- Reducing air pollution in terms of ozone and other air pollutants
- Ensuring continued healthy ozone levels,
- Maintaining the ozone NAAQS
