PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announces its proposed decision that no further

investigation or cleanup is required under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (RCRA).

for the Emtrol, Inc. facility (Facility).

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Facility is a former chlorinated solvent handling manufacturer that was converted into the Lancaster Campus of the York Technical Institute in 2003 and is located at 3050 Hempland Road Lancaster, PA 17601. It is a 7.1-acre parcel with an approximately 54,000 square-foot, single-story building. Based upon information referenced in the Administrative Record, EPA considers any spills and releases to have been remediated appropriately and protection of human health and the environment to have been achieved.

COMMENT PROCESS: Persons to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30-day comment period ending **Friday, January 12, 2018**. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Kevin Bilash, as listed above, and must be received prior to **Friday, January 12, 2018** All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the remedy is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the remedy is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new remedy and will reopen the comment period.
