

ELAB PBMS Workgroup

Description of Membership and Goal

On July 1, 1998, the Environmental Laboratory Advisory Board (ELAB), a Federal Advisory Committee authorized to provide advice to both NELAC and EPA voted to form a Workgroup to develop recommendations on the implementation of PBMS.

The Workgroup was charged with assembling a small, competent group of individuals representing key stakeholders—laboratories, instrument manufacturers, the regulated community, states, and EPA.

Goal: Provide a report with recommendations to ELAB to consider for submission to EPA and NELAC on the implementation of a Performance-Based Measurement System.

Key Attributes of Workgroup Members

- Familiarity with EPA's efforts on streamlining, PBMS, SW-846, etc.
- Active in PBMS, i.e., by providing comments, developing plans, presentations, etc.
- Familiarity with NELAC
- Competent analytical chemist, well grounded in fundamental concepts of method validation, QA/QC
- Representative of a key stakeholder interest-Laboratory, Instrument Manufacturer, Regulated Industry, State Accrediting Agency, EPA
- Demonstrated ability to work in consensus activity
