Re: Notification concerning RCRA permit
ESSROC Cement Corporation, IND 005 081 542
Effective Date of Uncontested Permit Conditions

On June 5, 2013, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a final Hazardous Waste Management Permit under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) to ESSROC Cement Corporation (ESSROC), Logansport, Indiana. The effective and expiration dates of the EPA's RCRA permit were July 5, 2013 and July 5, 2018, respectively. On July 3, 2013, prior to the effective date, ESSROC petitioned EPA's Environmental Appeals Board (EAB) to review the following permit conditions:

1. Permit Condition III.F.1;
2. Permit Condition III.F.2; and
3. Permit Condition III.F.3

This letter is to notify you that all conditions of EPA's permit, except the conditions specified above, will become effective 30 days from the date of this notification according to 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §124.16.

ESSROC operates a hazardous waste storage and treatment facility at Logansport, Indiana. ESSROC stores hazardous waste derived fuel in tanks and containers and then burns that fuel in two rotary cement kilns to facilitate the production of cement. The burning of hazardous waste in the cement kilns requires a permit under RCRA.

On July 22, 2012, EPA issued a draft RCRA permit for the two cement kilns and provided an opportunity for 45 days of public comment. EPA responded to the public comments and issued the final RCRA permit on June 5, 2013.


This RCRA permit, except the conditions specified above, will become fully effective and enforceable 30 days after the date of this notification. The RCRA Permit, except the conditions specified above, will remain in effect until July 5, 2018, unless revoked and reissued under 40 CFR § 270.41, terminated under 40 CFR § 270.43, or continued in accordance with 40 CFR § 270.51(a).

The permit conditions specified above will be stayed and will not be effective until the petition before the EAB is resolved. We will notify you concerning any resolution of these contested permit conditions.
