The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) hereby gives notice of proposed permit decisions under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) to Envirite of Ohio, 2050 Central Avenue, SE, Canton, Ohio. The proposed U.S. EPA permit is in conjunction with the RCRA permit issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and covers those regulations under RCRA that the Ohio EPA is not yet authorized to implement. It requires control of air emissions from the management of hazardous wastes in tanks and containers and includes 8 listed hazardous wastes.

After the close of the public comment period, the U.S. EPA will review all timely comments and make a final permit decision. Each person who submitted written comments will receive notice of the U.S. EPA's final determination and a formal response to significant comments.
