Subject: Ozone Advance Path Forward

Dear Ms. Bunte:

On February 3, 2016, the Washoe County Health District, Air Quality Management Division (AQMD) was accepted to participate in EPA's Ozone Advance program. A Path Forward Plan was prepared and submitted on February 2, 2017. The Plan details AQMD's strategies to improve air quality through collaborations, voluntary initiatives, and collective impact. The Path Forward Plan's five primary goals are to:

1. Reduce ozone precursor emissions from on-road motor vehicles
2. Reduce ozone precursor emissions from non-road motor vehicles and equipment
3. Reduce impacts from heat island effects that contribute to ozone formation
4. Increase efficiency of buildings, and
5. Expand air quality education and outreach programs

Attached is the first annual Path Forward progress report. It includes a summary of ozone monitoring data, recent initiatives supporting Ozone Advance goals, trends of key performance indicators, and goals for 2018 and beyond.
