In accordance with Section 309(g) of the Clean Water Act (CWA), 33 U.S.C. § 1319(g) AND 40 CFR § 22.45, notice is hereby given that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region III (EPA Mid-Atlantic Region), is proposing to file a Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) assessing an administrative civil penalty in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) against the Respondent named below for alleged violations of its NPDES permit.

SUMMARY OF VIOLATIONS: EPA Mid-Atlantic Region alleges the following violations of *National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit* No. PA-0063665 (MS4 Permit): 1) failure to annually report information on industries; 2) failure to fully maintain and implement a stormwater management program; 3) failure to provide a description of a comprehensive program to monitor and control pollutants from industrial facilities; 4) failure to conduct preventative maintenance inspections of all stormwater management facilities on a triennial basis; and 5) failure to conduct operation and maintenance of all municipal facilities.

These failures constitute a violation of Section 301(a) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. §§ 1311(a). These violations were discovered during an NPDES inspection of Respondent's MS4 in December 2014.

OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT: Persons wishing to comment on the amount of the proposed penalty are invited to submit a statement to the EPA Region 3 Water Protection Division Director, addressed to the attention of the Regional Hearing Clerk (address below), within forty (40) days of the date of this public notice. Comments received within this forty (40) day period will be considered. All comments must include the name, address, and telephone number of the writer and a concise statement of the basis for any comment and any relevant facts on which it is based.
