

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0028886

The discharge from this facility is located at 106 Assembly Creek, Sacramento, Otero County, New Mexico. Under the SIC code 7032, the applicant privately operates Sacramento Camp & Conference Center WWTP, which has a design flow of 0.042 MGD serving seasonal occupants. Effluent is chlorinated before discharged via Outfall 001 to an unnamed intermittent stream, thence to Agua Chiquita Creek, thence to Rio Penasco (Segment 20.6.4.208 of the Pecos River Basin). Designated uses of the receiving water are stated in the Fact Sheet, which is available.

This is a renewal of a permit issued on June 28, 2013, with an effective date of July 1, 2013, and an expiration date of June 30, 2018.

Changes from the previous permit are:

- Monitoring frequency for flow and pH have been increased.
- Monitoring of DO has been established.

#### State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
