Re: Notification of Consultation Regarding Tribal Minor New Source Review (NSR) Request for Coverage for Yavapai Apache Sand & Rock.

Dear Chairwoman Winiecki:

On October 17, 2017, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) received a Request for Coverage under the Hot Mix Asphalt Plants General Permit from Yavapai Apache Sand & Rock, for a permit under the Clean Air Act Tribal Minor NSR Permit Program (Facility ID #25; Application #2017-008-GP). The EPA is initiating consultation with the Yavapai Apache Nation of the Camp Verde Indian Reservation as part of our process for taking action on this request for coverage, consistent with the EPA Policy on Consultation and Coordination with Indian Tribes (www.epa.gov/tribal/epa-policy-consultation-and-coordination-indian-tribes).

The EPA invites you and your designated consultation representative(s) to participate in this process. If you choose to consult regarding this permitting action, we will work with your tribal government to develop a consultation plan, including a description of the process we would follow, opportunity for your input, and a timeline for us to provide feedback and to complete the consultation. We will send a draft consultation plan for your review as soon as practical after we receive your reply to this letter. The agency's goal will be to ensure that you have an opportunity to provide tribal input in this permit action.

Yavapai Apache Sand & Rock is proposing to construct a new 200 tons per hour stationary, parallel flow drum mix asphalt plant that will screen and crush materials for road bases and parking lots. The project would be located in 3750 W. Old Hwy 279, Camp Verde, Arizona 86322.
