## HOW SET-ASIDES WORK



Technical assistance and training are critical to sustaining our drinking water systems.

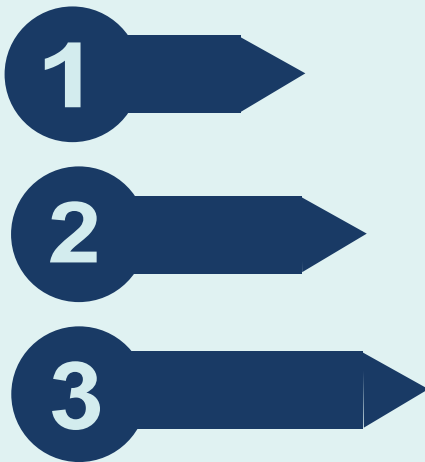
States may use up to approximately **31%** of their annual DWSRF grant (called a “set-aside”) from EPA to use for these activities.

All 50 States + Puerto Rico have DWSRF programs.



### PROGRAM FLEXIBILITY

States decide how much to set aside each year and which activities receive funding.

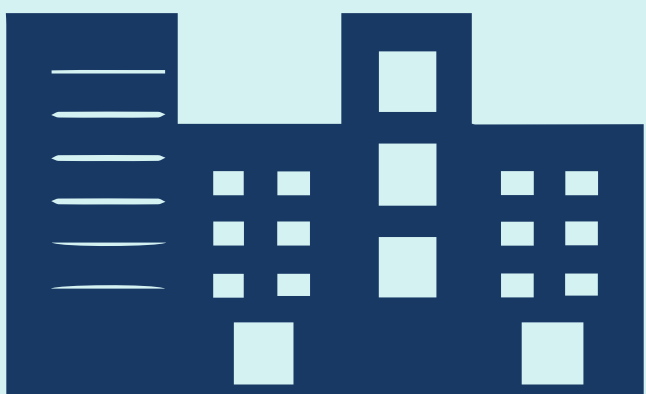


### EXAMPLE ACTIVITIES

- Technical Assistance to Water Systems
- Operator Certification Training
- Source Water and Wellhead Protection
- Asset Management Planning
- Public Water System Supervision Program Support
