TIPS ON STARTING A CARPOOL

1. Decide who will drive.

Will there be alternating drivers or will the same person drive every day?

2. Set ground rules.

Will someone in the car need to make stops along the way? Decide on things like smoking, eating or drinking in the car, and radio use before your first trip.

3. Set up a line of communication.

Make sure everyone in the car has each other's numbers in case of emergency. If someone cannot make it on a given day let the driver know as soon as possible.

4. Establish schedules.

Make sure schedules match up and establish times to be picked up. Make sure pick up points are established as well.

5. Have a back-up plan.

Whether you or the driver is sick, or an emergency comes up, make sure you have a back-up plan so you aren't stuck waiting for everyone else in the car if you need to leave early.
