LOCATION: Coachella, CA

INVITED WIFIA LOAN AMOUNT: \$29 million

POPULATION SERVED BY THE PROJECT: 89,000

PROJECT TYPE: Stormwater

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project is a 3.3-mile regional stormwater channel conveyance facility to manage and capture stormwater and reduce runoff and debris to the City of Indio and parts of the unincorporated county. The purpose of this project is to manage the stormwater runoff to nearby and adjacent properties and to maintain the environmental integrity of the area.

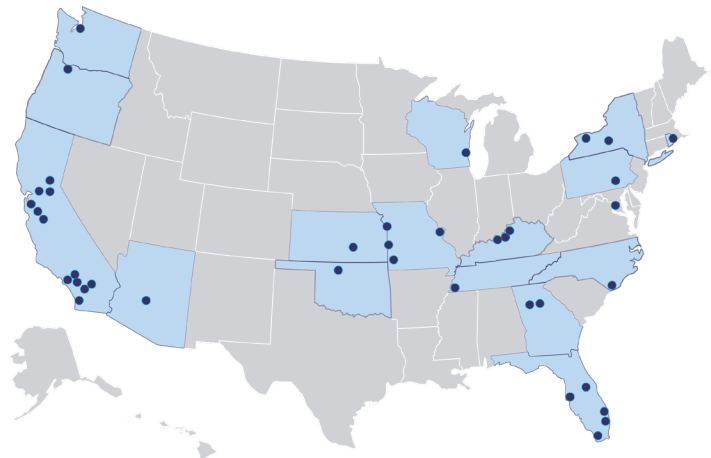

Selected borrowers must apply for a WIFIA loan, pass a final creditworthiness assessment, negotiate a mutually agreeable term sheet, and execute a credit agreement to receive WIFIA financing. An invitation to apply indicates that EPA believes the selected projects will be able to attain WIFIA loans.
