PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Comprehensive Infrastructure Repair, Rehabilitation and Replacement Program will rehabilitate, upgrade, and/or replace aging water and wastewater infrastructure throughout the system. The purpose of the program is to efficiently distribute drinking water and collect, treat, and discharge wastewater to protect the public and reduce nutrient loads and combined sewer overflows to local water bodies.

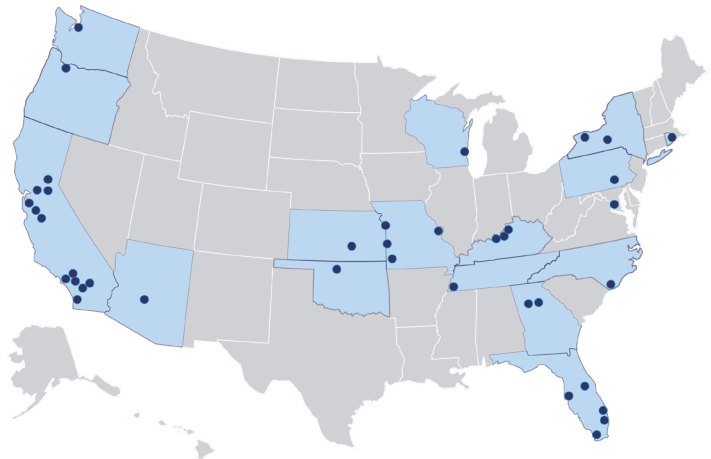

Selected borrowers must apply for a WIFIA loan, pass a final creditworthiness assessment, negotiate a mutually agreeable term sheet, and execute a credit agreement to receive WIFIA financing. An invitation to apply indicates that EPA believes the selected projects will be able to attain WIFIA loans.
