PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Priority Areas Sewer Assessment & Rehabilitation Program Consent Decree Packages project will rehabilitate and repair an aging wastewater collection and treatment system. The rehabilitation work includes: sewer replacement, pipe bursting, full or partial length sewer lining, point repairs, manhole interior coating or lining, manhole height adjustment and/or frame and cover adjustment or replacement, connection sealing, and/or manhole replacement at various locations within the County. The purpose of the project is to assess and rehabilitate the sewer system infrastructure to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) and comply with the December 2011 SSO Consent Decree.

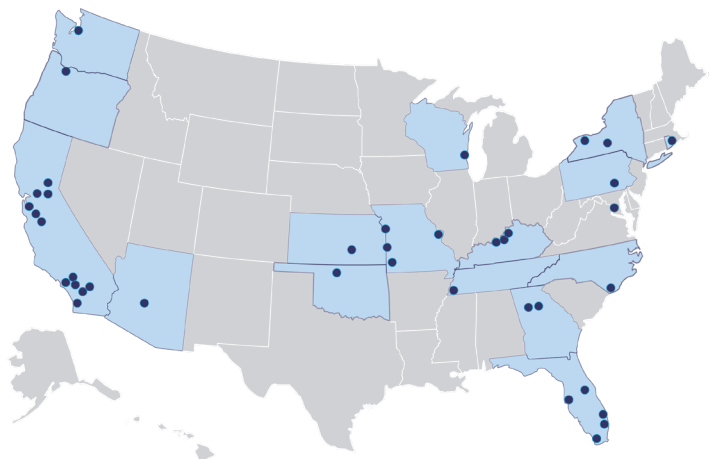

Selected borrowers must apply for a WIFIA loan, pass a final creditworthiness assessment, negotiate a mutually agreeable term sheet, and execute a credit agreement to receive WIFIA financing. An invitation to apply indicates that EPA believes the selected projects will be able to attain WIFIA loans.
