

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0031208

The discharge from this facility is located on Pearl Valley Road (CR 43) at U.S. HWY 62, City of Hobbs, Lea County, New Mexico. Under the SIC code 4950, the applicant privately operates a proposed WWTP named Quail Run Services – Hobbs, which has a discharge flow of 0.15 MGD; expected date to discharge is January 1, 2019. Effluent is chlorinated before discharged via Outfall 001 to unnamed tributary to Ironhouse Draw and/or Monument Draw. Designated uses of the receiving water are stated in the fact sheet, which is available.

This is a new discharger.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
