Some in the media have reported that EPA employees would not get any pay during the shutdown, but, as you know, EPA remained open for one additional week, from December 23rd to December 28th, following the lapse in appropriations. As a result, I want to report that EPA employees will receive one-half of their salary for a normal pay period for the week of December 23rd on the upcoming regularly scheduled pay date this week. Understandably, many staff were concerned about the complete lack of another paycheck.
