

Mercury Inventory Reporting Rule Summary

The Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act (2016), which amends the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), requires EPA to triennially publish an “inventory of mercury supply, use, and trade in the United States.”

Amended TSCA:

- Defines mercury for the purpose of this reporting, as both “elemental mercury” and “a mercury compound.”
- Directs EPA to:
 - Identify any manufacturing processes or products that intentionally add mercury; and
 - Recommend actions, including proposed revisions of Federal law or regulations, to achieve further reductions in mercury use.
- Authorizes EPA to develop a reporting rule to collect information.
 - The final rule published on June 27, 2018.

Mercury Inventory Reporting Rule Summary

- Reporting requirements under the final rule apply to “any person” who:
 - Manufactures (including imports) mercury;
 - Manufactures (including imports) mercury-added products; and/or
 - Otherwise intentionally uses mercury in a manufacturing process.
- Data required to be reported include:
 - Amount of mercury produced, imported, stored, used, sold, or exported (no matter how small the amount);
 - Types of mercury-added products made;
 - Types of manufacturing processes and how mercury is used;
 - Business sectors to which mercury or mercury-added products are sold;
 - Country of origin of imported mercury or mercury-added products; and
 - Destination country for exported mercury or mercury-added products.

Reporting Cycle

Each company subject to the reporting requirements must report for activities during the designated calendar year once every three years.

The TSCA mercury inventory rule ("Mercury; Reporting Requirements for Toxic Substances Control Act Mercury Inventory") requires manufacturers (including importers) and processors to report information to assist in the preparation of an inventory of mercury supply, use, and trade in the United States, where *mercury* is defined as *elemental mercury* and a *mercury compound*. The requirements apply to any person who manufactures (including imports) mercury or mercury-added products, or otherwise intentionally uses mercury in a manufacturing process. These persons must report to EPA the quantity of mercury they manufacture, use, import, store, sell and/or export. In some cases, EPA also requires identification of the industrial sector, trading country, type of product, and type of manufacturing process.

The Mercury Electronic Reporting (MER) application includes embedded help files and a downloadable user manual to guide you through the MER submission process. Reporters may submit information for elemental mercury, mercury compounds, or both in one report to the Agency.

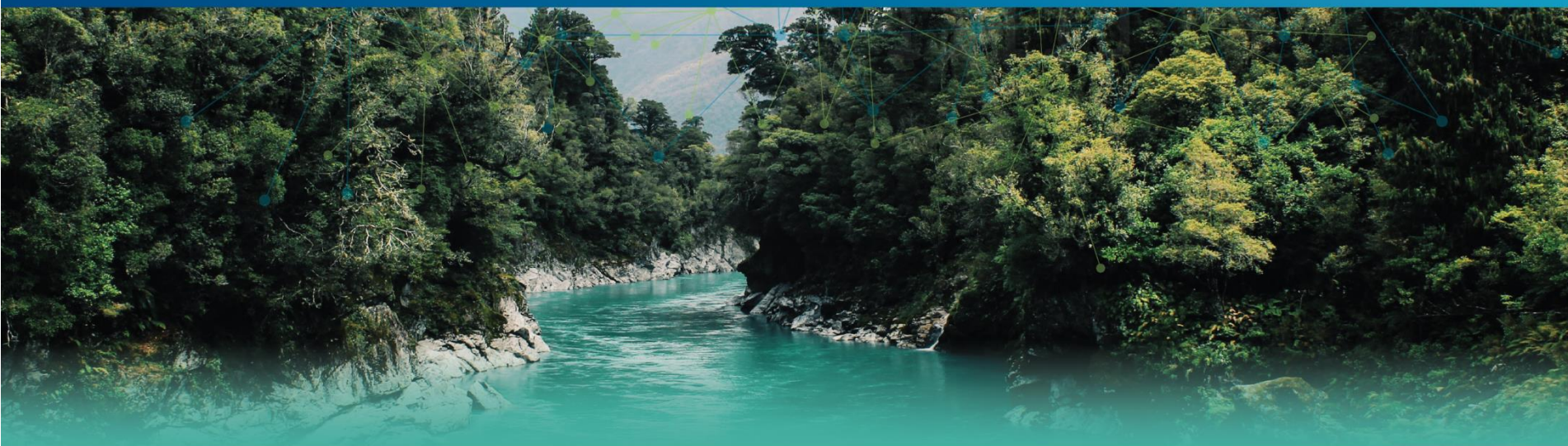
