

## **Public Notice: Saint Marys Metal Finishing Company - Saint Marys, PA**

**DATE OF THIS NOTICE:** 7/15/2019

**PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE:** Proposed RCRA Corrective Action - Cleanup Complete for Saint Marys Metal Finishing Company Facility in Saint Marys, PA

**FACILITY DESCRIPTION:** The Facility is located at 1057 Trout Run, St. Marys, Elk County, PA 15857. The Facility conducts three kinds of plating operations: Plastic impregnation, electronic zinc plating, and electroless zinc phosphate plating. Hazardous wastes generated at the facility include cadmium waste (D006), chromium waste (D007), spent cyanide plating bath solution (F007), and cyanide plating bath residue (F008). The Facility currently operates as a Small Quantity Generator.

**COMMENT PROCESS:** Persons to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30-day comment period ending **Wednesday, August 14, 2019**. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Tran Tran, as listed above, and must be received prior to **Wednesday, August 14, 2019**. All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

**FINAL DECISION:** EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the remedy is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the remedy is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new remedy and will reopen the comment period.
