PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed decision that corrective action is Complete With Controls under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (RCRA), for the BASF Corporation-Ambler Facility (Facility).

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Facility is located at 300 Brookside Avenue, Ambler, PA. The site manufactured metal treatment products, herbicides and pesticides. Investigations were completed and arsenic, ethlybenzene, benzene, and 1,2-dichloroethane were found above Pennsylvania's Statewide Health Standards. EPA's proposed decision requires land-use and groundwater-use controls to ensure continued non-residential and non-potable uses of the property.

COMMENT PROCESS: Persons wishing to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30 day comment period ending September 28, 2019. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Linda Matyskiela, as listed above, and must be received prior to September 28, 2019. All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the decision is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the final decision is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new decision and will reopen the comment period.
