



### Number of fields/farmers

- ▶ 30 different fields
- ▶12 different applicators

### **Auxin Applications**

- Crossbow applied across from one field before the plastic was placed into the field
- ► Engenia was applied 3000 yards from fields D-1 and 500 on June 20<sup>th</sup>
- ► No auxin use near the shortoff fields in the south around the time of damage



### Signs that it might not be drift

- ► No damage to Liberty or Round-up beans located close to tomatoes
- ► No damage to surrounding vegetation
- Staggered time frames of damage. First damage was 6 weeks before last
- ▶ Private lab results returned with ND

### What does it mean?

- ► Stinger Herbicide has a 24 c label for strawberries in NC.
- ► Was used on adjacent fields
- ► Runoff due to wet spring
- ► Contaminated water was used to irrigate the tomatoes
- ► Build up over time had delayed damage

### Lessons learned

- ► Trust your gut
- ► Ask plenty of questions
- ► Faster lab turn around
