PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed decision that corrective action is Complete with Controls under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (RCRA), for the Mactac Industries, Scranton Facility (Facility).

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Facility is located at 802 East Corey Street, Scranton, PA. Mactac is a specialty coater of papers, films, and foils using solvent based, aqueous based, hot melt, and solid silicone systems. Investigations were completed and only Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons were found above EPA's Regional Screening Level risk range. EPA's proposed decision requires land use controls to ensure continued non-residential use of the property.

COMMENT PROCESS: Persons to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30-day comment period ending **Sunday**, **September 15**, **2019**. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Linda Matyskiela, as listed above, and must be received prior to **Sunday**, **September 15**, **2019** All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the remedy is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the remedy is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new remedy and will reopen the comment period.
