Public Notice: Flint Group Pigments - Huntington, WV

DATE OF THIS NOTICE: 11/12/2019

PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed Draft Statement of Basis (SB) for environmental remediation at the Flint Group Pigments Facility Parcel 43 and 45 (Formerly: BASF, XSYS Print Solutions U.S.) (WVD000068601) under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 provisions of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Flint Group Pigments Parcels are located at 5th Avenue & 24th Street Huntington, WV 25721 on approximately 8 acres.

Primary Contaminants are PCBs and chlorinated solvents.

EPA's proposed remedy for the Facility includes Institutional and Engineering Controls for two parcels of the Flint Group Pigments facility. The Parcels 43 and 45 completed the RCRA Corrective Action process. The proposed Remedy is: (1) soil excavation, consolidation and offsite removal, (2) institutional controls limiting the land and groundwater use and (3) managing indoor vapor exposure.

COMMENT PROCESS: Persons to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30-day comment period ending **Thursday**, **December 12**, **2019**. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Leonard Hotham, as listed above, and must be received prior to **Thursday**, **December 12**, **2019**. All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the remedy is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the remedy is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new remedy and will reopen the comment period.
