

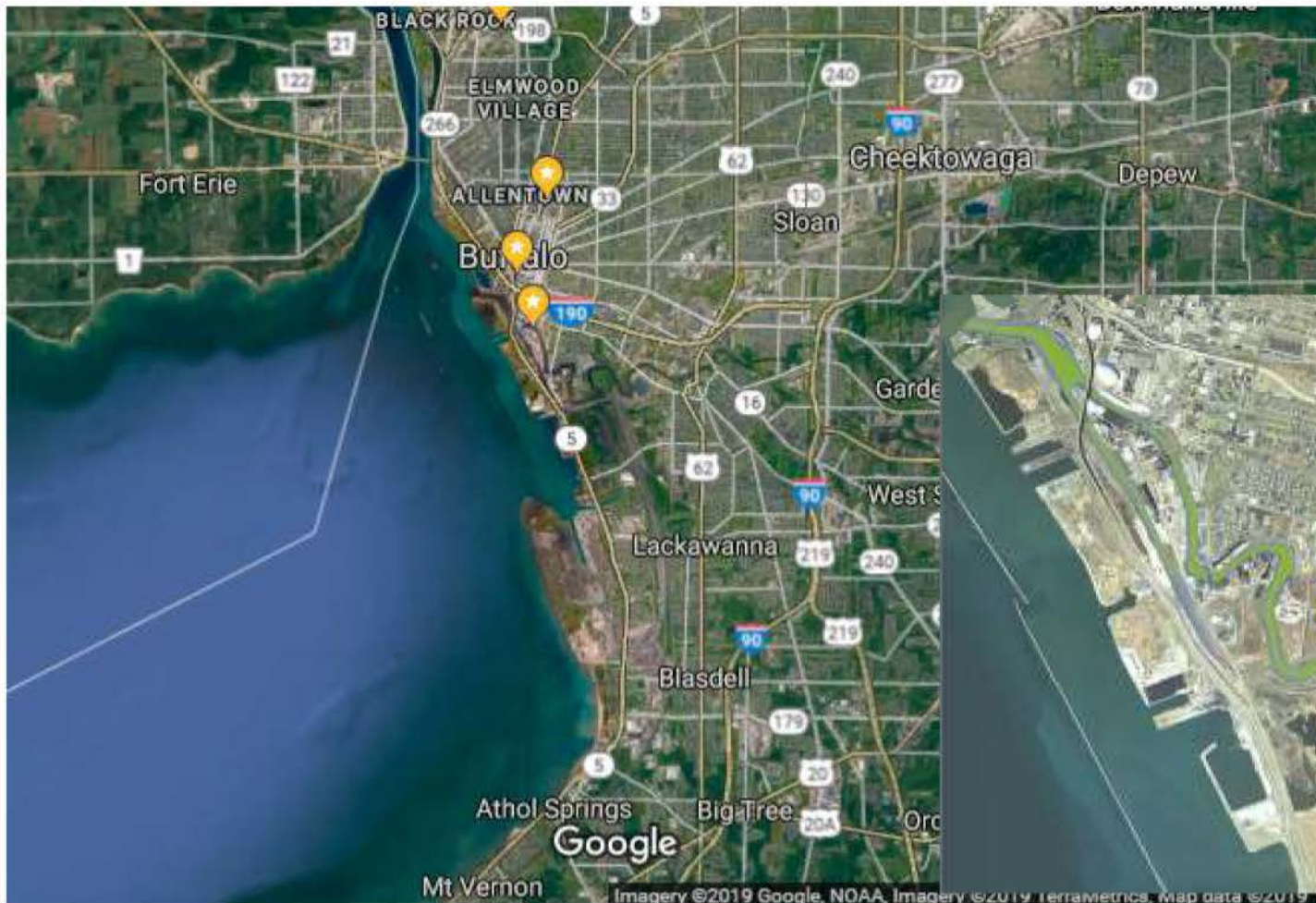

HEENEY IS GAME BUT OUTCLASSED

Tunney, Debonair and Cool, Chops Foe
to Ribbons, Landing Almost at Will,
Until Referee Calls Halt.

YANKEE STADIUM, NEW YORK, July 27.—The age-old story of science triumphing over brute force again was told under a canopy of glaring ring lights to 40,000 excited and anxious spectators at Yankee stadium last night.

Gene Tunney, debonair product of Greenwich Village, representing the thoughtful and artistic side of pugilism, scored a technical knockout over the hairy-chested and mudgum-faced New England blacksmith, Tom Heeney, in the 11th round of a battle that saw the champion of the world attack new technique.

Trainer On to Protest.

When referee Edith Purcell stepped between the boxers and waved Heeney to his corner, a temporary truce was there were only eight seconds to go before the end of the round. But only one man, James Martin, Heeney's trainer, raised a voice to protest. As for the rest, they were in accord with the action. Heeney could not have won. And he was being chopped into ribbons by an opponent who was landing at will.
