Safety-Kleen Systems Inc., Smithfield Recycle Center (SRC) has applied to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency for the renewal of the previous issued EPA Approval to commercially store polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) under Section 6(e)(1) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C. § 2605(e) and 40 CFR § 761.65(d). PCB regulation currently falls under the exclusive authority of the EPA.

SRC owns and operates a commercial storage facility located in Smithfield, Kentucky. SRC provides commercial storage of PCB waste as well as hazardous, industrial, universal, and non-hazardous waste to commercial customers. SRC consolidates, repackages, and sorts waste for shipment off-site for treatment and/or disposal. SRC operates a single storage area in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 761.65(d) for PCB wastes. The EPA has completed its review of the SRC renewal application for the commercial storage of PCB waste and has prepared a proposed TSCA PCB Approval. The proposed TSCA PCB Approval sets forth conditions for managing PCB waste, establishes facility closure procedures, and requires SRC to maintain financial assurance to cover facility closure cost for the PCB waste and storage areas. The EPA has determined that the application meets the requirements set forth in the regulations and that operation of the facility in accordance with the requirements of the TSCA PCB Approval will not pose an unreasonable risk of injury to human health or the environment.

Persons wishing to comment on the EPA's decision to issue the proposed TSCA PCB Approval are invited to submit comments by letter or email during the 30-day public comment period beginning **January 29, 2020** and ending **February 28, 2020**. The EPA will finalize its decision after review of and response to all received written comments.
