The County will consider various project types, including direct heating, electricity generation, renewable natural gas production, or other proven technologies. The landfill has an active gas collection and control system, and the existing LFG electricity project is currently idled. The County holds the rights to all facilities and equipment associated with the existing project except for the electrical grid connection.
