Notice of Proposed Permit Reissuance for EnerVest Operating

The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 3 (EPA) is reissuing a proposed permit under the authority of the federal Underground Injection Control (UIC) regulations at 40 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Parts 124, 144, 146, and 147 to EnerVest Operating.

Description: EnerVest applied for the renewal of one (1) UIC Class II injection well permit, to be used for the disposal of produced fluids. The injection well is located in the Nora Field, Ervinton District, Dickenson County, Virginia. The draft permit will allow EnerVest to inject produced fluids into the Weir formation at depths of approximately 4,690 feet. If the final permit is issued to EnerVest, it will remain in effect for ten (10) years. A permit is required to meet the provisions of the EPA-administered UIC Program in Virginia.

Requests for Public Hearing: Requests to hold this public hearing must be received via email or telephone by EPA by October 23, 2020. When requesting a public hearing, please state the nature of the issues you propose to raise. EPA expressly reserves the right to not hold a hearing unless a significant degree of public interest is evidenced by October 23, 2020.
