

# Introduction

- ▶ The Manufacturer Information module is being redesigned to improve the user experience and ensure information is accurate and complete for all industries
  - ▶ Incorporating as much feedback as possible that has been received from manufacturer and EPA system users over the years
  - ▶ Targeting a production deployment in early 2021. EPA will notify manufacturers when a date for the production deployment has been determined
    - ▶ Information presented today is preliminary and may change as development work continues
  - ▶ EPA will schedule a webinar for manufacturers in early 2021 where we will announce the dates when manufacturers will have an opportunity to get familiar with the redesigned module in a test environment
  - ▶ IMPORTANT: There will be some things every manufacturer should do before and after the redesigned module is deployed to production

# Redesign Objectives- Require Annual Affirmation

- ▶ Every 12 months, a CROMERR Signer must affirm that the Manufacturer Information for their Manufacturer Code is accurate and complete
  - ▶ Affirmation can be completed as frequently as desired
  - ▶ The 12-month clock will reset at the time of each affirmation
  - ▶ If more than one CROMERR Signer exists for your company, all will be able to perform the affirmation, but only one must do it annually
  - ▶ The initial affirmation will be required within 30 days after production deployment

# Redesign Objectives- Require Annual Affirmation

- ▶ All users who have been granted the EV-CIS CROMERR Signer role will:
  - ▶ View and be able to click on an affirmation checkbox on the Manufacturer Information “Review & Confirm” screen
  - ▶ Receive email notifications at 45 days, 30 days, and 15 days prior to the annual affirmation deadline in their CDX inbox and to email addresses provided for any Contacts with “CROMERR Signer” selected as a Contact Role
  - ▶ Not be able to submit requests for certificates or CSI updates if the annual affirmation deadline has passed, since the “Request Certificate or CSI Update” button on the EV-CIS Home will be deactivated. These features will be restored once the affirmation is completed
  - ▶ Need the EV-CIS Submitter role in order to edit any of the Manufacturer Information besides the affirmation checkbox. To learn how to add roles to existing EV-CIS user accounts, see:

# Redesign Objectives- Require Annual Affirmation

- ▶ Users with any EV-CIS role(s) will:
  - ▶ See the “Deadline for Next Affirmation by a CROMERR Signer” on the confirmation screen after each Manufacturer Information submission
  - ▶ See the date the Manufacturer Information was last updated on the “Maintain Manufacturer Information” button on the EV-CIS Home
  - ▶ See a warning message on the EV-CIS Home beginning 15 days prior to the annual deadline and continuing until the annual affirmation has been completed by the CROMERR Signer

# Redesign Objectives- Information Updates

- ▶ **Consolidate tabs:**
  - ▶ Assigned EPA Compliance Engineers moved to the Applicable Industries tab
  - ▶ Test Labs moved to the Locations tab
  - ▶ Notifications moved to the Contacts tab as a new indicator for each Industry/Compliance Program combination
- ▶ **Add new fields and update lists of values:**
  - ▶ Industries
  - ▶ Location Types for each Location (select all that apply)
  - ▶ Contact Roles for each Contact (select all that apply)
- ▶ **Eliminate obsolete fields and tabs**

# Redesign Objectives- Dynamic & Role/Industry-based Content

- ▶ Dynamic content on Locations and Contacts tabs as information is entered
- ▶ Divisions and Alternate Manufacturers tabs will only be visible if “Light-Duty Vehicles and Trucks” or “Heavy-Duty Highway Class 2b/3 Vehicles” are selected as industries since they do not apply to any other industries
- ▶ Only users with the EV-CIS Submitter role will have ability to edit Manufacturer Information
- ▶ Only users with the EV-CIS CROMERR Signer role will be able to annually affirm that Manufacturer Information is accurate and complete
- ▶ On-screen validation on each tab and business rules for all tabs that are processed when users click the “Review & Confirm” button
  - ▶ Business rules will also be applied in the Request for Certificate module requiring all referenced locations, test labs and contacts to be active

# Redesign Objectives- New Features

- ▶ Comment field visible and can be edited on all tabs
- ▶ Edit previously submitted records
  - ▶ Applicable Industries, Locations, Contacts, and Alternate Manufacturer Permissions (Note- Divisions may not be edited)
- ▶ Search within all records on each tab
  - ▶ Including pending and inactive records
- ▶ Enabled notifications will be sent to CDX inbox and all email addresses entered for that contact
- ▶ Expand/collapse records to toggle between summary and detailed views of information
- ▶ View/hide inactive records
- ▶ A warning pop-up will appear after 10 minutes of inactivity to minimize potential loss of pending changes after 20 minutes

# Redesign Objectives- Updated Look And Feel






- ▶ Consistent and simple layout and content
- ▶ Consistent header and footer across all tabs
- ▶ Use of defined icons and functions that mean the same thing in every context
- ▶ Ability to choose how many records to display on each screen (including “All”)
- ▶ Easy-to-read view mode and clearly identified editing mode
- ▶ Pending changes identified with new “Pending” icon and highlighted on each tab and Review & Confirm screen
- ▶ Make a record active/inactive with a toggle

# Applicable Industries Tab- Features

- ▶ This list of industries will match the industry lists that are used for the Submit Certification Information and Submit Compliance Information buttons on the EV-CIS Home
- ▶ Identifies all selected & unselected industries for your Manufacturer Code
- ▶ Ability to view assigned EPA Compliance Engineers for each industry when mousing-over the  icon
- ▶ If a user deselects an industry from the list of Selected Industries, that industry will instantly move to the list of Unselected Industries and will be grayed-out and indicated with a Pending icon until it is submitted
- ▶ If a user selects an industry from the list of Unselected Industries, that industry will instantly move to the list of Selected Industries and will be highlighted and indicated with a Pending icon until it is submitted



# Applicable Industries Tab- Things To Do

- ▶ After the redesigned module is deployed to production, every manufacturer must do the following:
  - ☑ Select all industries that are currently active for any EPA certification or post-certification compliance activities
    - ▶ Certification and compliance information can only be submitted for selected industries
    - ▶ Each selected Industry must have at least one Contact associated with it on the Contacts tab
    - ▶ The Divisions and Alternate Manufacturers tabs will only show up if “Light-Duty Vehicles and Trucks” or Heavy-Duty Highway Class 2b/3 Vehicles” are selected
  - ☑ Deselect all industries that are not currently active for any EPA certification or post-certification compliance activities
    - ▶ Any Industry/Compliance Program associations on the Contacts tab for the deselected industry will also need to be updated

## Locations Tab- Features

- ▶ The legacy Addresses tab will be called Locations
- ▶ Ability to search within all active and inactive records
- ▶ Locations can be expanded to view details or collapsed to view a summary
- ▶ Ability to add as many Locations (i.e., addresses) as needed that are used for EPA certification and compliance purposes
  - ▶ Including 3<sup>rd</sup> party locations
- ▶ Each active Location must be selected for at least one contact



## Locations Tab- Features

- ▶ The manufacturer-provided Location Name must be unique
  - ▶ This was called Address Label in the legacy module
- ▶ Values for the new Location Type(s) field include (select all that apply):

## Locations Tab- Features

- ▶ Select as many values as apply for the new Location Type(s) field
- ▶ Many EV-CIS datasets have Location and Test Lab fields with drop-down lists that will only include active Locations that have a specific value selected for Location Type
  - ▶ Only Locations with “Manufacturing Facility/Assembly Plant” selected as a Location Type will be included in the drop-down list of any manufacturing-related fields in certification datasets
  - ▶ Only Locations with “Test Lab” selected as a Location Type will be included in the drop-down list of any Test Lab-related fields in certification and compliance datasets
  - ▶ (MC/ATV-Only) Only Locations with “Third Party” selected as a Location Type will be included in the drop-down list of the Catalyst Manufacturer Name field in the certification dataset



## Locations Tab- Features

- ▶ Test Lab information will be a possible attribute of each Location by selecting “Test Lab” as a Location Type, where applicable
  - ▶ The separate Test Lab tab will no longer exist
- ▶ An EV-CIS Test Lab ID will be system-assigned after a new Location with a Location Type of “Test Lab” is submitted
  - ▶ The assigned Test Lab ID will never change, even if a location is edited, made inactive, or if “Test Lab” is deselected and later reselected as a Location Type
- ▶ Test Lab information cannot be edited after a Test Lab ID has been assigned
  - ▶ If a test lab needs to be updated, change the Status of the incorrect one “Inactive” and create a new Location/Test Lab
- ▶ To make a Test Lab inactive, either change the Location Status to “Inactive” or deselect “Test Lab” as a Location Type



## Locations Tab- Features

- ▶ If “Test Lab” is selected as a Location Type, you must also provide the following test lab information:
  - ▶ Is this test lab owned by another company that has its own EPA Manufacturer Code? (Yes/No)
    - ▶ If “Yes” (meaning a different company owns the test lab and they have their own EPA Manufacturer Code), then you must provide:
      - ▶ EPA Manufacturer Code of Test Lab Owner
      - ▶ EV-CIS Test Lab ID of Test Lab Owner
    - ▶ If “No” (meaning your company owns the test lab or a different company owns the test lab but they do not have their own EPA Manufacturer Code) then you must provide:
      - ▶ The full address of the test lab
- ▶ All test labs that are owned by a different company that has their own EPA Manufacturer Code (including EPA’s NVFEL test lab in Ann Arbor, Michigan) should be entered by referencing the test lab owner’s EPA Manufacturer Code and Test Lab ID instead of manually entering the address details



## Locations Tab- Things To Do

- ▶ After the redesigned module is deployed to production, every manufacturer must do the following:
  - ☑ Review all new Locations which were created by the system during migration to the redesigned module for any of your Test Labs in the legacy module that had the same address selected as other Test Labs
    - ▶ The new Location Name will initially be set to the legacy Test Lab Name and can be modified if desired
    - ▶ The Test Lab ID for the new Location in the redesigned module should be the same as had been previously assigned in the legacy module
    - ▶ Update the address details if the incorrect address had been selected in the legacy module (which is likely for many of the Test Labs where the same address was selected as other Test Labs)
    - ▶ If any of the new Locations are for Test Labs that are owned by a different company that has their own EPA Manufacturer Code but are not entered by referencing the test lab owner's EPA Manufacturer Code and Test Lab ID, you will need to follow the instructions on [slide 30](#)



## Locations Tab- Things To Do

- ▶ After the redesigned module is deployed to production, every manufacturer must do the following:
  - ☑ Select all applicable values for the new Location Type(s) field for all Locations since it will be blank for most Locations the first time the redesigned module is accessed
    - ▶ Test labs that were migrated from the legacy module will already have “Test Lab” selected as a Location Type
  - ☑ If needed, update the Location Name for any Location to facilitate selecting the correct Location in certification and compliance datasets
    - ▶ Each Location Name must be unique
  - ☑ Change the Location Status to “Inactive” for any Locations that are no longer used for EPA certification or compliance purposes
    - ▶ However, you will only be able to use Locations/Test Labs whose Status is “Active” in certification and compliance datasets



# Locations Tab- Things To Do

- ▶ After the redesigned module is deployed to production, every manufacturer must do the following:
  - ☑ If needed, update the address details for any addresses that were migrated from the legacy module
  - ☑ Enter any additional Locations that are used by your company for EPA certification and compliance purposes
  - ☑ Confirm that all test labs that are owned by a different company which has their own EPA Manufacturer Code are entered by referencing the test lab owner's Manufacturer Code and Test Lab ID instead of manually entering the address (see instructions on [slide 30](#))
    - ▶ EPA's NVFEL test lab in Ann Arbor, Michigan must be referenced since no manufacturer Locations in the redesigned module will be allowed to have an address of "2000 Traverwood" or "2565 Plymouth"



## Locations Tab- Things To Do

- ☑ **How to reference a different manufacturer's test lab:**
  1. Change the Status to "Inactive" for any existing Locations/Test Labs that do not reference the test lab owner's EV-CIS Test Lab details
  2. Contact the test lab where your EPA certification or compliance tests were (or will be) conducted to request their EPA Manufacturer Code and EV-CIS Test Lab ID
  3. Click the "+ Add Location" button and enter a Location Name and select "Test Lab" for Location Type
  4. Answer "Yes" for the question "Is this test lab owned by another company that has its own EPA Manufacturer Code?"
  5. Enter the values received in Step 2 for EPA Manufacturer Code of Test Lab Owner and EV-CIS Test Lab ID of the Test Lab Owner (enter "EPA" and "1" for EPA's NVFEL test lab in Ann Arbor, Michigan). After submitting this information, the new Test Lab will be assigned its own EV-CIS Test Lab ID for your Manufacturer Code
  6. If needed, update any in-progress family datasets (e.g. CSIs, Applications, Engine/Evaporative/Vehicle Family datasets) with the new Test Lab ID received in Step 4, since all Test Lab IDs must be active in order to be included in certification or compliance datasets

# Contacts Tab- Features

- ▶ Ability to add as many company contacts as needed
- ▶ Ability to search within all active and inactive records
- ▶ Each contact can be expanded to view details or collapsed to view summary
- ▶ All CAOs, CROMERR Signers, and EV-CIS Submitters for your company should have a Contact in Manufacturer Information
  - ▶ “CROMERR Signer” should only be selected as a Contact Role after completing the separate EPA approval process to add the EV-CIS CROMERR Signer role to a user’s CDX account
  - ▶ Selecting “CROMERR Signer” in Manufacturer Information does not automatically make a user a CROMERR Signer



## Contacts Tab- Features

- ▶ For each contact, you must provide/select:
  - ▶ Full Name
  - ▶ Primary Email Address
  - ▶ Up to 3 additional Email Address(es) (including any group emails)
  - ▶ Phone Number(s) and Phone Type for each Phone Number
  - ▶ Address (only active locations entered on the Locations tab will be included in the Address drop-down list)
  - ▶ Applicable Industries/Compliance Programs
  - ▶ Notification Indicator for each Industry/Compliance Program combination
  - ▶ Contact Role
    - ▶ Select all that apply from the list of values on the next slide
    - ▶ Only contacts that have a specific value selected for Contact Role will be included in drop-down lists of contact-related fields in certification and compliance datasets (e.g., "Agent for Service")



# Contacts Tab- Features

- ▶ All notification email addresses must now be entered for specific contacts instead of as stand-alone emails
  - ▶ The legacy Notification Emails tab will no longer exist
  - ▶ None of the legacy Notification Emails will be migrated to the redesigned module since they were not linked with specific contacts
  - ▶ Any group emails should be entered as Additional Emails for specific contacts and not as the Primary Email Address for any contact
  - ▶ Emails will be sent to all email addresses entered for a contact for all Industry/Compliance Program combinations that have notifications enabled
  - ▶ All Notification Indicators will default to “Off” and must be changed to “Yes” in order to receive email notifications

- ▶ Values for the Contact Role field include (select all that apply):

- ▶ The value of “Buyer” is for the Locomotive Exempted Engines Buyer field, which is required for Production Volume reporting
- ▶ The legacy value of “Other” will no longer be an option



## Contacts Tab- Things To Do

- ▶ After the redesigned module is deployed to production, every manufacturer must do the following:
  - ☑ Select all applicable Contact Roles for each contact from the new list of values
    - ▶ At least one Contact Role must be selected for each Contact
    - ▶ The values for Contact Role have changed, so most Contacts will not have any values selected the redesigned module
    - ▶ Many EV-CIS certification datasets have contact-related drop-down lists that will only include contacts that have a specific value selected for Contact Role (i.e., "Agent for Service", "Buyer", or "Importer") and that have the applicable industry and a Compliance Program of "Certification" selected




