Thank you for your February 23, 2010 submission of Pennsylvania's Primacy Revision Application under the Public Water System Supervision Program for the Groundwater Rule (GWR), the Stage 2 Disinfectants/Disinfection Byproducts Rule (Stage 2 D/DBPR), the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment (LT2) Rule, and minor revisions to the Variance and Exemption (V&E) Rule. The application package has been deemed complete and final. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) ninety-day review period, as per 40 C.F.R. §142.12(d)(3), begins on the date of this letter. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §142.12(e), Pennsylvania is not eligible for interim primacy for any regulations that were promulgated after the Phase II-V Rule until the state submits and EPA approves a complete and final package for the Phase II-V Rule.
