## RFP for LFG Energy Project in Florida - 11/18 Meeting



As a service to our Partners and other stakeholders, EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is sharing information about a **request for proposals (RFP) from Volusia County, Florida for a landfill gas (LFG) energy project at the Tomoka Farms Road Landfill**. Please note that EPA is not affiliated in any way with the review and selection process. Information provided below is based on the RFP.

Volusia County seeks proposals from qualified respondents to **design**, **build**, **finance**, **own and operate a facility to recover energy from the LFG** at the Tomoka Farms Road Landfill. The County seeks to enter into an LFG purchase agreement under which the successful respondent would make payments for the rights to recover and beneficially use the LFG. The landfill has an existing gas collection and control system; currently all collected LFG, approximately 2,400 to 2,800 cubic feet per minute, is flared.

As an option to the main proposal, the County is also interested in **disposal of at least 40,000 gallons per day of leachate** from the landfill.

A pre-proposal conference will be held at 2:00 PM [EST] on Wednesday, November 18, 2020 at the Tomoka Farms Road Landfill Administration Building, 1990 Tomoka Farms Road, Port Orange, Florida 32128; this conference is not mandatory but attendance is encouraged. Questions will be accepted through January 5, 2021. Proposals must be received by 3:00 PM [EST] on January 19, 2021.
