Enclosed is your copy of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 8 Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit (Permit) for the above-referenced project area.


The public comment period ended on November 4, 2020. We received comments on the Draft Permit during the public notice period. Also included with this letter is a copy of the response to comments that documents changes to the Final Permit. As these comments were received during the public comment period, the Final Permit becomes effective 30 days from the date of issuance per Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) § 124.18, to provide a 30-day window to appeal the Final Permit decision. All conditions set forth herein refer to CFR parts 124, 144, 146 and 147, and are regulations that are in effect on the date this Permit becomes effective.

Please note that under the terms and conditions of this Final Permit, you are authorized to construct (i.e., convert) and operate the proposed injection well, A-7R. Prior to commencing injection, you must ensure that all requirements found in the Final Permit, Part II Section B.2, have been met. It is your responsibility to be familiar with, and to comply with, all the provisions in the Final Permit.
