Emerald Transformer, PPM, LLC (Emerald Transformer) has applied to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency for renewal of their Approval for Commercial Storage, Processing and Disposal of Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCB) waste oil under Section 6(e)(1) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 United States Code 2605(E) and 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Section 761.65 (d). PCBs are man-made chemicals and their regulation currently falls under the exclusive authority of the EPA.

Emerald Transformer owns and operates a commercial storage and disposal facility in Tucker, Georgia. Emerald Transformer receives PCB waste oil. This waste oil is unloaded to designated storage tanks for temporary storage, until the waste oil can be processed for disposal in their chemical de-chlorination treatment process.

Emerald Transformer operates commercial storage, processing and disposal in accordance with 40 CFR Sections 761.65(d) and 761.60(e) for the PCB wastes. Title 40 of the CFR, Protection of Environment, is the section of the CFR that deals with EPA's mission of protecting human health and the environment. The EPA has completed its review of the Emerald Transformer's renewal application for the storage and disposal of PCB waste and has prepared a proposed PCB Approval. The proposed PCB Approval sets forth conditions for managing PCB waste, establishes facility closure procedures, and requires Emerald Transformer to maintain financial assurance to cover facility closure cost for the PCB waste and storage areas. The EPA has determined that the application meets the requirements set forth in the regulations and that operation of the facility in accordance with the requirements of the PCB Approval will not pose an unreasonable risk of injury to health or the environment.

Persons wishing to comment on the EPA's decision to issue the proposed PCB Approval are invited to submit comments by email or phone during the 30-day public comment period beginning February 1, 2021 through March 5, 2021. The EPA will finalize its decision after review of and response to all received comments.
