
Collaborative Problem Solving Grant: San Luis Valley Ecosystem Council located in Alamosa, Colorado

Project Description

The identified issue for this project is resident exposure to contaminants (e.g., metals, fertilizers) via household wells. The environmental and/or public health result desired is a reduction in the number of residents within the Valley who are exposed to contaminants through their drinking water source. SLVEC and its partners plan to achieve their desired goal through:





- (2) educating health care providers so that they will provide services and information to affected residents to reduce exposure and to reduce associated health problems;
- (3) promoting and implementing new technologies that are cost effective, which will allow low-income residents to afford filtration systems or to drill for new wells.
