

ESC Self-Declares ISO 14001 Conformance




fter successful completion of an internal audit and a management review meeting, the ESC can now claim completion of the environmental management system (EMS) and conformance to the international standard ISO 14001. Following two years of diligent work by the EMS Implementation Team with assistance from ESC staff and managers, the EMS plan-docheck-act cycle has been completed. This allows us to "self-declare" that we have implemented the system as we prepare for an independent third-party audit. The result of the third-party audit, which begins August 7, will be issuance of a formal certificate of registration around the end of September this year.
