



Environmental Impact of Buildings

In the US, buildings account for:

- > 39 % of total energy use
- ▶ 12 % of the total <u>water</u> consumption
- ▶ 68 % of total electricity consumption
- > 38 % of the CO2 emissions
- ▶ 60 % of total non-industrial <u>waste</u> generation (C&D)
- ▶ 60 % of all materials (excluding food and fuel)

EPA has a fundamental interest in assuring that buildings are healthy places to live, work, and learn; that energy use is dramatically reduced; and that buildings use water, materials, products and land in a sustainable manner.
