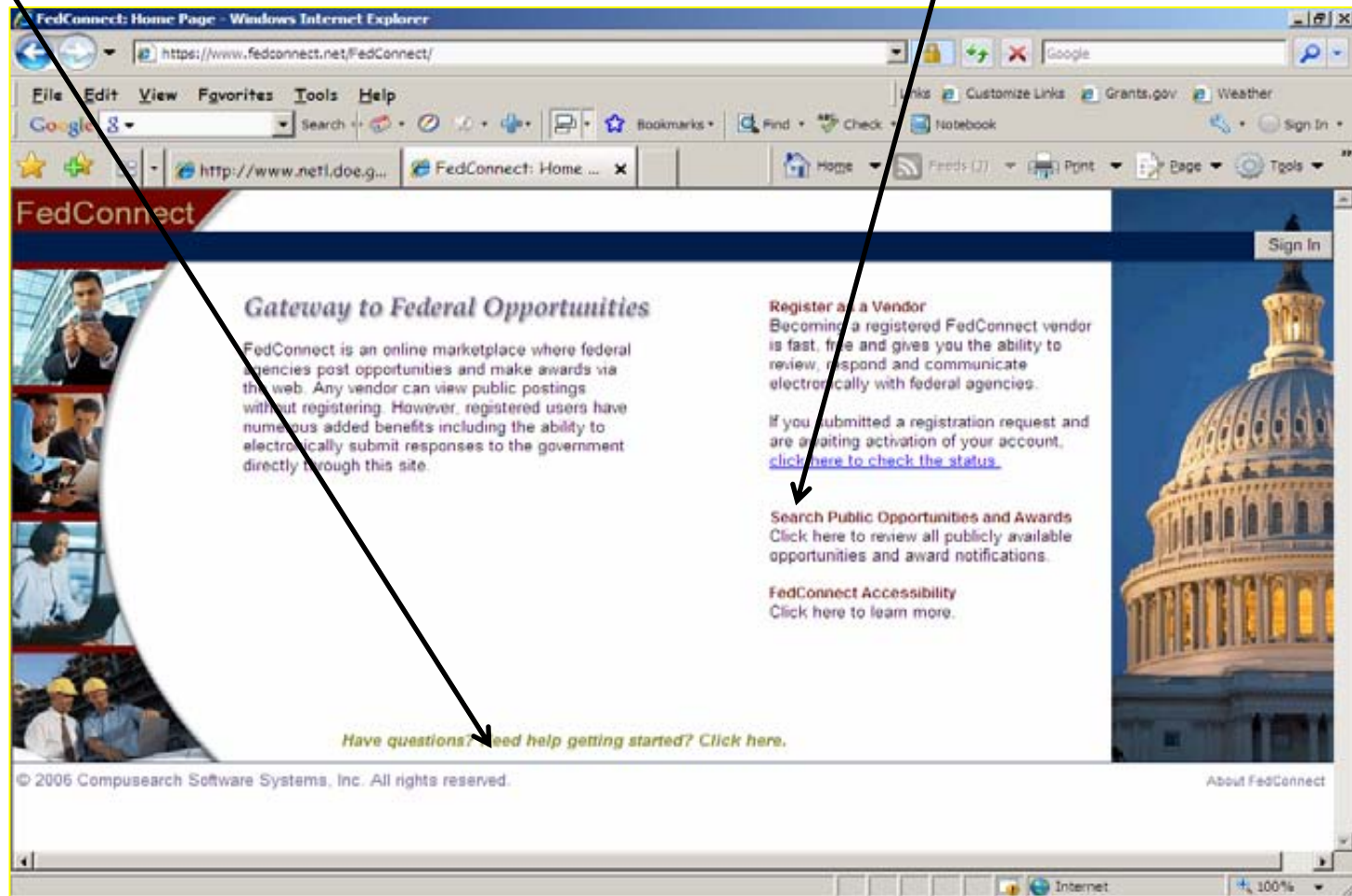
Doing Business with the Federal Government

- There are several one-time actions you must complete in order to submit an application in response to this Announcement.
Applicants must:
 1. Obtain a Dun and Bradstreet Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number at http://www.dnb.com/US/duns_update/
 2. Register with the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) at <http://www.ccr.gov/>
 3. Register E-Business Point of Contact with FedConnect to submit their application at www.fedconnect.net
- Applicants who are not registered with CCR and FedConnect, should allow at least 21 days to complete these requirements. It is suggested that the process be started *now*.



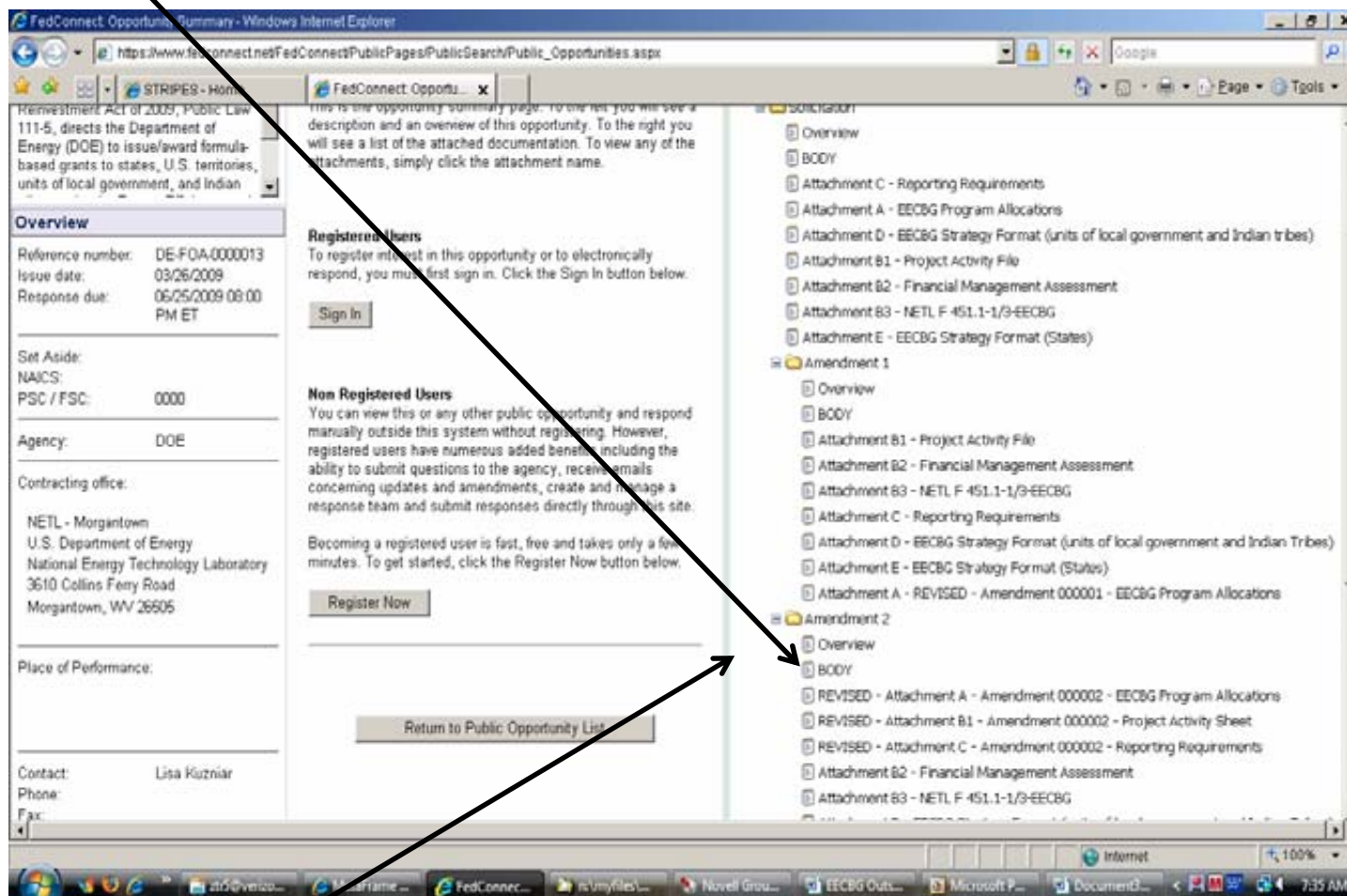

- Once you download the application package, save it on your computer. This is the only step you need to do in Grants.gov.
